Funding received – Grants from Bideford Bridge Trust £1,500; Bideford Town Council £2,000; £950 from TDC Cllrs Peter Christie (£200), David Fulford (£500) and Tony Inch (£250)

Tales of the Riverbank June to September – A series of community participatory and educational activities set around the river Torridge in the Bideford and Bay Area. The activities focussed on and explored the local history, heritage and the natural environment. These included walks, talks, visual art, public and artists' responses to history and the environment.

20 workshops, walks and talks plus 2 associated events
Attended by 280 people. Income from Eventbrite bookings and on the day = £471.87

Future plans 2016:

Projects confirmed to date:

Way of the Wharf – Community project for Brunswick Wharf. Peoples Health Trust grant £19,024. BBC have been awarded a grant from the People's Health Trust to deliver a community led project centred around Brunswick Wharf. This will enable us to work with funded neighbourhoods in East the Water and Bideford

Project plans 2016 - 2018

- 1. Develop Tales of the Riverbank year 2 Bideford Bridge Trust grant application rejected but is included in application to Bideford Town Council. Could be conversations, creative responses outdoors/on site, performances, demonstrations and exhibitions. Could also link into Brunswick Wharf project
- 2. Develop Culture Show Awaiting outcome of grant application from Bideford Town Council. Open up to local, Regional and National artists. Theme to be agreed; continuing this partnership with local businesses to deliver more publicly visible temporary and permanent creative works to enhance the town centre; to instill a sense of pride and encourage visitors
- 3. Deliver a Summer programme of live music and performance on Jubilee Square
- 4. Bideford Festival/weekender working with schools, youth groups, residents and the local community to tell stories celebrating history, heritage and the natural environment through the power of music, performance, art, demonstrations and community workshops.
- 5. Heritage project to put old photos of buildings on the outside of them to show what a street / space / building used to look like
- 6. Wall painting a community arts project to produce a mural on the 500ft long by 6ft high football ground wall (opposite Morrisons)
- 7. Work in partnership with the Devonshire Association's Devon Newfoundland project April 2017 which celebrates the relationship between these two places and in particular Bideford's pottery and fish trade. Plans are for a 1 or 2 day event in Bideford to include talks, demonstrations, music and live performance, workshops, historical information working with The Burton, Maritime Museum, local schools, Devon Family History society, Learn Devon, Records office and Community archive
- 8. Network and connect more with Bristol, Plymouth and Exeter Sadie and Dave attended 'Beyond Resilience' workshop at Exeter library September; Plymouth Weekender in September. Made contacts and gained inspiration
- 9. Early project idea started with Director of the Phoenix in Exeter about a North South Tarka line project connecting Exeter to Bideford

Future plans:

- encourage associations and partnerships supporting and working with creative practitioners (including young people and emerging artists), groups, arts and cultural organisations primarily in Bideford town and Bideford Bay, and also throughout Devon, the South West Region and Internationally
- Continue to develop projects that emerge out of collective ideas, excitement, enthusiasm and passion such as developing skills, creating audience for the arts, creating and showcasing artworks of all media and practices.
- Have a 'can do' attitude that also celebrates and encourages art for arts sake and art and culture for health and well being; recognising the value of the arts and culture in all our everyday lives.
- Initiate and manage Projects that are physical or virtual, local or global, ideas based or production of new work based, educational or just inspirational.

Other ideas - develop a programme of projects that are web based and social media based to create International creative dialogue and audience

Other things to consider/opportunities:

Connecting to new Bideford Town Centre Partnership – plans for a town centre events coordinator being discussed, approval from the Town Council but not funded as yet
